*Please note that to be considered for the scholarship all application materials must be submitted by **April 8, 2022, 11:59 pm**. **Incomplete applications will NOT be considered.**

Requirements:

Below is a list of requirements for students applying for the Raul Elias Reyes Scholarship. Signing and returning this application acknowledges your commitment to the following:

- Must be participating in at least one of the following experiences:
 - Summer course(s) (Summer enrollment required)
 - Summer study abroad (Summer enrollment required)
 - Summer unpaid internship (Summer enrollment not required)
- Must have at least a 2.6 GPA.
- For the Summer experiences that require summer enrollment, you must be enrolled as a student at Michigan State University for the summer 2022 semester.
 - Submit all documentation to confirm your enrollment. Please send all documents in a PDF File.
- Submit all documentation to show proof of your summer experience including proof of an unpaid internship, proof of enrollment in a summer study abroad program, and the courses.
 - Submit all documentation to confirm your experience. Please send all documents in a PDF File.
- Submit 1 letter of recommendation (i.e. MSU Faculty, Community Leaders, Mentors, etc.)(optional, but highly recommended)
- Submit the attached scholarship application by the deadline.
- If awarded with the Raul Elias Reyes Scholarship, the funds will only be awarded after the submission of a billing statement.
- If awarded with the Raul Elias Reyes Scholarship, the recipient must attend Theta Alpha Chapters' second annual Panther Ball on April 21st, 2022.
- If awarded with the Raul Elias Reyes Scholarship, the recipient will be required to complete a formal presentation of their experience.
 - A formal presentation must be given to the members of Sigma Lambda Gamma National Sorority, Inc. (Theta Alpha Chapter) within two weeks after the end date of the summer experience.
 - The presentation should be 5-10 minutes in length.
 - Must include visual aids (pictures, power points, souvenirs, etc.)



Personal Statement:

As part of your scholarship application, you are required to provide a (12 pt. font, Times New Roman, double-spaced) typed personal statement. Please include the following questions as a guideline when writing your personal statement:

- What is your major? Why have you chosen this major?
- Have you had a summer experience before?
- How will taking this summer experience affect both your academic and personal life?
 - What are your academic goals for the upcoming school year?
 - Have you been actively involved in community outreach and involvement (i.e. clubs, activities, athletics, organizations, etc.)? If so, how?
 - What courses have influenced you to gain leadership qualities. Have you earned any recognition for these courses? (i.e. honors, awards, achievements, self-discipline, etc.)?
- Describe your culture/background and what it means to you.
